



Barry Marshall Travel Award - Conditions

Background

Professor Barry Marshall AC, Patron of the Spinnaker Health Research Foundation and Nobel Prize Laureate, received a travel grant from the then Medical Advisory Committee of Fremantle Hospital while a registrar at the hospital in 1983. This gave Prof Marshall the opportunity to present his preliminary findings on the *Helicobacter pylori* research which ultimately earned him and his colleague Dr Robin Warren AC a joint Nobel Prize. Prof Marshall credits this travel grant as providing the means by which he was able to convince his peers of the significance of the discovery. The Barry Marshall Travel Award has been established to pay tribute to Prof Marshall's great achievements and to foster a culture of innovation and information sharing. The awards are generously donated by Prof Barry Marshall AC and his wife Mrs Adrienne Marshall.

Eligibility

- Health professionals and medical researchers, including clinicians, allied health staff and scientists, based at the Fiona Stanley Fremantle Hospitals Group (FSFHG) or collaborating universities and health research institutes within the South Metropolitan Region of Perth;
- The applicant must give an oral presentation about his or her research at a reputable national or international conference within 6 to 8 months of the date of award;
- A clear connection to the FSFHG must be established;
- The abstract must have been accepted by the conference organiser for an oral presentation.

Funding

- 1 award per application round of up to \$2,500 each
- Funding must be used in relation to the conference such as travel costs, accommodation, and conference fees but can't be used for salary costs, entertainment including alcohol.
- Any unused funds are to be returned to Foundation.

Assessment Criteria

- Scientific merit and impact of work to be presented and of the conference
- Significance and relevance to the Fiona Stanley Fremantle Hospitals Group
- Prior conference presentation of this and other research relative to opportunity will be taken into consideration

Reporting & Approvals

- The recipient is required to submit a 1-2 page lay-language report plus photo/s about their experience, impact and any collaborations developed. This report will be included in the Spinnaker communications materials such as annual review, website or other fundraising communication.
- The recipient must provide all receipts of incurred costs for reimbursement (pre-payments can be arranged where possible such as flight ticket).
- The recipient is expected to present at a Spinnaker Health Research Foundation event for researchers and / or donors / supporters if invited.
- The recipient must acknowledge the Spinnaker Health Research Foundation at all presentations and in all publications of his or her research.

Application procedure

There will be two rounds of applications in 2018.

- The 1st round will consider conferences taking place during the second half of 2018
- The 2nd round will consider conferences taking place in the first half of 2019.
- ❖ Using the application form, submit a case for support by addressing eligibility, detailed funding requirement / budget and the assessment criteria.
- ❖ Lodge application by the due date as per activity schedule.

The Spinnaker Scientific Advisory Committee advises the Board on the merits of each application. The Board of the Spinnaker Health Research Foundation makes a final decision in its absolute discretion.

Round 2

16 August	Applications open – submit by email and mail the signed original hardcopy
13 Sept	Applications close
22 Oct	All applicants notified of outcome including successful recipient
By end June 19	Recipient must have presented his or her research
By July 2019	Lay report, acquittal and photo/s sent to the Foundation for promotional purposes
Dec (TBC) 2019	Recipient to accept the award at the Annual Awards Night
